







Research Projects Requested by Members of Provincial Parliament**• An Update on Social and Affordable Housing and Homelessness Programs in Ontario**

This report will review the Province's social and affordable housing and homelessness programs, identify recent program and spending changes, and estimate the impact of these programs on core housing need, chronic homelessness and other key objectives.

• 2025 Budget Capital Plan Review

This report will review the Province's 10-year capital plan in the 2025 Ontario Budget, including analyzing how planned infrastructure spending is allocated across sectors, funding sources and types of projects. The report will also compare the 2025 budget capital plan to previous capital plans and to actual infrastructure spending over the past 10 years.

• Major Infrastructure Projects Review

This report will assess the cost of select infrastructure projects.

• Assessing the Impact of the Province's Private Housing Supply Policies

This report will examine the impact of the Province's policies to support the goal of building 1.5 million homes in Ontario by 2031. The report will discuss how housing contributes to Ontario's economy, examine the historical and projected trends in the supply of housing in Ontario, assess the potential impact of the Province's policies to increase private housing supply, and examine how this increased supply could affect house prices, rents and home affordability for Ontarians of varying income levels.

• The Potential Impacts of Removing Interprovincial Trade Barriers on Ontario's Economy and Finances

This report will highlight how interprovincial trade contributes to Ontario's economy, examine interprovincial trade barriers and assess the potential impacts of the removal of these barriers on the province's economy and finances.
